

Feed-in Tariff Application Process

Now the PV System is up and running it will provide electricity for the building. You should also be entitled to the UK Government's Feed-In Tariffs scheme (FITs) meaning you get money from your energy supplier. You can be paid for the electricity you generate, even if you use it yourself, and for any surplus electricity you export to the grid. And of course you'll also save money on your electricity bill, because you'll be using your own electricity.

In order to claim the FIT you will need to contact your electricity supplier and request an application form, this can usually be downloaded from their website. Fill in the form and return to your supplier.

Once this has been received by the electricity provider they should write back to you with copies of their FIT agreement and T&C's. They will also provide details about how to provide them with meter readings (usually requested on a quarterly basis) which will allow them to calculate the amount of money you are entitled to. All electricity that is produced is recorded on the generation meter, this is clearly marked in the mains intake cupboard.

On the application form you are known as "The Generator". The form may ask some questions you do not already know. So included in the handover pack on the Project overview page are some details for you to help you fill in the form.
